Steaming on Magnificent Cedar Lake: 2022 Recap

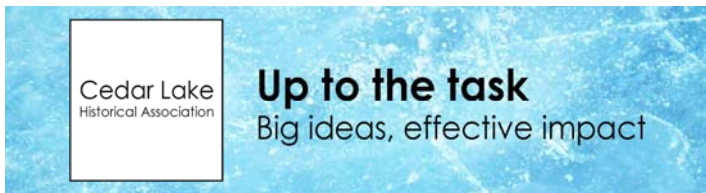
