Grant Awarded

The Indiana Historical Society (IHS) has awarded CLHA a \$45,000 Heritage Support Grant made possible by Lilly Endowment, Inc. to fund façade enhancements to the historic Lassen's Resort Hotel. Projects already completed include a complete exterior siding repainting, shingle repair, and the installation of new gutters. Read the press release at lassensresort.org/about.
