
MIDWAY BALLROOM NEWSLETTER

Here is a southern view of part of the Midway Ballroom and a lovely sight that you will probably see as you dance to the nations' top name bands. Only in the evening the view is more beautiful with the moonlight reflecting on the water. The ballroom is entirely over water from two feet to a depth of eight feet. There is a large dancing area; an open air walkway for between dances. On the north side of the ballroom is an open air patio serving our dancing customers. To the front of the ballroom, in a separate room, is located "The Pine Room" with a large circle bar and plenty of tables for couples. There is no charge to go in "The Pine Room" and is for the convenience of those who only want to relax over a cool drink and listen to the music. The Midway Ballroom is located approximately five miles southwest from Crown Point and fifteen miles from Hammond or Gary. It is easily accessable from the Chicago and Calumet region by just coming east on the Expressway and south on Route 41 to Cook. Turn left at Cook and continue around the lake.

You will especially enjoy our new open air patio which will be for the convenience of our dancing customers only. 


FRANK YANKOVIC
